**Key Duties and Responsibilities:**

Applies foundation theoretical and practical knowledge and skills and evidence based guidelines based on established body of professional precedents. Understands and responds to client needs, balancing day-to-day priorities with client and operational requirements, identifying and addressing problems and modifying practice as needed. Accountable for the planning, provision and communication of nursing/midwifery care to an allocated group of clients. Follows defined service quality standards, work health and safety policies and procedures relating to the work being undertaken in order to ensure high quality, safe services and workplaces.

**Selection Criteria:**

**Essential:**

1. Current registration as a Registered Nurse with Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia or eligible for same.
2. Demonstrated experience conducting accurate, comprehensive and systematic assessments, analysing information and data and communicating outcomes as the basis for practice.
3. Demonstrated collaboration with clients, organisations and the wider multi-disciplinary team to ensure best clinical outcomes.
4. Demonstrated effective communication skills to engage others in a mature, confident manner to achieve positive client outcomes, including providing information and/or advice on clinical issues within the Registered Nurse/Registered Midwife scope of practice.
5. Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of the social and cultural issues, influences and sensitivities that influence Nursing/Midwifery care provision for clients and families.
